Application information for 2022

Eligibility (Meet all requirements):

1. Be a 2022 high school graduating senior or an enrolled college student (who has not received a Men's Club Scholarship before).
2. Be an active member of St. Stephen Catholic Community.
3. Have a grade point average of 2.0 (grade of "C") or higher.
4. Show proof of acceptance at a vocational, community college, private college or university.
5. Not be a previous winner of a St. Stephen Men's Club Scholarship.

How to Apply

1. Read the entire packet before starting.
2. This is a fillable form and entries can be typed directly in the lines and boxes. Then save and print out this form for submittal.
3. Or, if you prefer, please print this form, and **type or print legibly in black ink**.
4. Answer all questions. If an answer does not apply, state "N/A" or "not applicable" on the form.
Incomplete applications will not be considered by the committee.

5. Enclose all of the following items:

Application

1. High school Official transcript and/or a college transcript, whichever is applicable
2. Letter of Acceptance from your selected college or vocational school (a copy w/signature from the school is acceptable)
3. Three letters of reference.
4. Essay of why you need this scholarship.

6. Enclose the application and required documents in an envelope and return to **the church office starting 4/4/2022** clearly marked with the following:

The award amount to be distributed for scholarship(s) is determined annually. The Men's Club may, at its discretion, award the designated total to more than one applicant. The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution you will be attending in your name. Please be sure that the college or university address of your selected institution is on the acceptance letter from your choice. Scholarships are not limited to in-state schools.
